**Fulfilled** is a study by Sonja Corbin. Sonja was brought up Baptist. In her adult life joined the Catholic Faith. Sonja’s strong study of the Bible immediately saw in the Catholic Faith how the church was set-up just like the temple was set-up by God in the desert Moses and the Israelites.

As an example in the study, Sonja first observed the Holy Water fount when a parishioner’s enters the church. The same observance in the Old Testament is carried over into the New Testament. In the Old Testament in the desert, the high priest would sacrifice the animals for the sins of the people. After the sacrifice, the priest would enter the temple court yard to wash his hands in the court yard fountain to wash away the sins of the people. Catholics observe the same ritual. Catholics enter the church body, go to the Holy Water fount to bless themselves after the parishioner, a laity priest, make sacrifices in the world entered the church body and washes away the sins by blessing themselves with Holy Water.
